# ASSESSMENT EXERCISE

Section I:

For the following exercise, using the Code of Student Life (<http://handbook.uark.edu/code-of-student-life/student-conduct/student-standards.php>) indicate which violation(s) the acts below constitute. Use the number designations from the Code that best describe the violation (Section B), you may use more than one violation per incident. All of the acts occurred on campus and have been referred to the University of Arkansas Office of Student Standards and Conduct. Then, using your own judgment, rate the severity of the violation (1 = not severe at all, 2 = somewhat severe, 3=moderately severe, 4= very severe). Finally, assign and describe for each act what you believe to be an appropriate sanction. You are encouraged to use the disciplinary sanctions outlined in the Code of Student Life in addition to educational sanctions you develop for the violation.
